This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 27 out of which the school can run not more than 6 sections in secondary classes i.e. 3 in class IX and 3 in class X and not more than 8 sections in senior secondary classes i.e. 4 in class XI and 4 in class XII, subject to the condition that the school shall not run more than 1/4 and 1/3 of the total sections running in the school at any point in time at the secondary level and senior secondary level, respectively. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 for a classrooms size of 500 sq ft and above. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board based on the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of land and class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension. The school is directed to run at least 01 section each of Bal-Vatika I, II & III in accordance with established norms permitted vide Board's circular no. 12/2023 dated 24-03-2023 & 25/2023 dated 11-09-2023.
2	The school does not have sufficient number of classrooms of size greater than or equal to 500 Sq.Ft. As school is already running 25 sections from classes 1-10, school shall construct more classrooms of requisite size for accommodating classes for senior secondary level, within 03 months and submit compliance with videography.
3	Science specific labs still have some deficiencies. In Physics and Biology labs, school has arranged normal class benches for seating, which are not appropriate furniture for labs and should be replaced with sturdy wooden stools. Further, no electric connections/sockets for conducting practicals have been seen on the demonstration tables available in Physics lab. In Biology lab, school has made provision of utilities

	like water and gas connections on side slabs, whereas the utilities should have been provided on the work-stations in the centre of the lab. School shall upgrade the labs, as per Board's SOPs within 03 months and submit compliance with videography.
4	The school does not seem to have referred to RPwD Act and guidelines of the Board for CwSN toilets. Some of CwSN toilets are still small in size. The door can not be closed with wheelchair inside (video reference time 1:14:58). Review inspection committee has reported that newly constructed building of the school does not have CwSN toilets in new building block. As per board's circular no. 11/2024 dated 09.08.2024, separate CwSN toilets for girls and boys should be maintained on the ground floor of the school building. If classes are conducted on any floor other than the ground floor, separate CwSN compliant toilets for boys and girls with adequate space for the Wheelchair / Walker must mandatorily be maintained on those floor(s) as well. School shall comply with the revised guidelines for CWSN as per Circular No. 11/2024 dated 09.08.2024, within 03 months and submit the compliance with videography.
5	Review inspection committee has reported that newly constructed building of the school does not have ramp for accessing upper floors. As per board's circular no. 11/2024 dated 09.08.2024, if the school conducts classes or Practicals for CwSN on any floor other than the ground floor, it shall mandatorily make provisions for a lift or ramp to access those floors. School shall comply with the guidelines for CwSN as per board's circular dated 09.08.2024, within 03 months and submit compliance with videography.
6	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Bhopal within 03 months and submit the compliance.
7	The school is directed to ensure that all essential valid documents are available under the head Mandatory Public Disclosure (as per annexure – IX) on school's website at all time and the link of certificates should be remain functional and submit an undertaking in this regard on its letter head duly signed by the principal and manager of the school in the compliance within 03 months.
8	As per the recommendation of NEP, the school shall ensure the participation of its students in the Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning(SAFAL), an exam conducted by the Board every year. This exam, designed to assess and enhance students' learning, is a valuable initiative for their holistic development, as per the guidelines issued by the Board vide circular no: Acad-49/2024 dated 26 June 2024.
9	The school will ensure the Holistic Progress Card (HPC) is used for the foundational stage according to the guidelines issued by the Board via notification no. CBSE/Director (Acad.-Assessment)/2023 dated 27.12.2023.
10	The school shall submit an undertaking to upload all requisite information regarding students, teachers, and infrastructure details available in the school on the UDISE and OASIS Portals. The registration of the students in class IX and XI shall be conditional on the school providing complete information on the UDISE and OASIS Portals.
11	The school shall ensure that all teachers undergo at least 50 hours of Continuous Professional Development (CPD) every year, vide notification no. 16/2021 dated 24.09.2021, out of which 25 hours should be from COE Bhopal.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.

2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.

If fencing/grill is required, then the same should be over and above 6 feet height.
 2. Ramps at the entrance(s) as well as Ramps/lifts for CWSN, to access the upper floors of the school (in case of a multistoried school) (Circular No. CBSE/AFF-05/2023 dated 06.03.2023).
 3. Separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor (in case of multistoried schools) (Circular No. CBSE/AFF-05/2023 dated 06.03.2023).

4. Appropriate laboratory infrastructure for Secondary School (Composite Science Lab, Mathematics Lab, Computer Lab) and for Senior Secondary School (Composite Science Lab, Mathematics Lab, Computer Lab, Physics Lab, Chemistry Lab, Biology Lab.) (Circular no. CBSE/AFF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
5. Well stocked library with adequate reading area. (Circular no. CBSE/AFF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
6. Well-developed indoor and outdoor sports facilities. (Circular no. CBSE/AFF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
7. Well-developed Digital Infrastructure (Circular No. CBSE/AFF-10/2023 dated 24.03.2023)

Failure to comply within the prescribed time may invite financial penalty @ 50,000/- per month until compliance is submitted and may debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students' class IX to class XII, as the case may be.
